Project Brief

The Michael Uren Biomedical Engineering (BmE) Research Hub is a flagship building at the College's White City Campus, dedicated to research and innovation in science, engineering, medicine and business. Designed as a collaborative facility, the BmE Hub will provide space for researchers, engineers, scientists and clinicians to work alongside one another to address biomedical and healthcare.

The BmE Hub has been made possible by a £40 million gift from alumnus Sir Michael Uren and his Foundation. This gift has laid the foundations for an unprecedented investment in facilities dedicated to biomedical engineering research. Imperial and the IBME are now actively evaluating opportunities for pioneering research initiatives which will occupy the building and benefit from this unique infrastructure and a revolutionary expansion in the field at the College.

The 14 storey arrow shaped facility will feature a concrete frame structure. A glazed façade with prefabricated and geometrically distinct concrete fins to two elevations will provide solar shading as well as complementing the building's striking design.

iSG were appointed Principal Contractor. Construction commenced January 2017, with a completion due September 2019.
