Project Submission Instructions for MSc Students

Turnitin is software the Department uses to help detect plagiarism. You are able to re-submit a newer version of your project anytime up to the deadline; the version that is present in the App on 14th September at 4pm will be accepted as your FINAL version.

You may find it useful to submit a draft version of your project earlier than the deadline date and then view the Similarity Report to check for possible plagiarism and improve your referencing. It is not expected that you would need to resubmit more than 1 or 2 times whilst improving your work, thus the Turnitin Report function will only be available to you a few weeks before the final submission deadline. Please see the Turnitin guides in the Library Resources folder for more information on plagiarism and referencing.

Please note: once you have submitted your project, you will not be able to resubmit another version for 24 hours. You MUST leave sufficient time before the deadline to ensure you can submit the final version of your project for assessment.



SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Log in to the app: https://apps.ee.ic.ac.uk/mscproj/ The app works well on Chrome/Firefox/Opera

- 2. To submit your Project:
 - a. Click on Submit Project button.
 - b. You will be directed to the Project Title Confirmation Page rather than being prompted to upload, you can either continue with the project title as is or change the title.

c. On the submit Project page: Choose a file to upload and click on Upload button.



3. Once the Project is submitted a Download Project button will appear on the dashboard under the download column and you will receive a successful upload confirmation from the system.

Please be aware that after submitting your project, you will have 24 hours to submit another version. You MUST allow enough time before the deadline to ensure you can submit the final version of your project for assessment.



4. Once the Project is submitted, Turnitin report will be generated, and you will receive an email notifying you to login to your Project submission dashboard. You will be able to download Turnitin report from Downloads section. **NOTE:** after successful project submission, it may take 5-60min for your Turnitin report to be generated. This depends on the size of the document.
