#### **Deadlines**

Applications are to be received no later than 15 April 2016. Applicants will be notified as to whether they have been successful and fellowship recipients will be informed no later than 13 June 2014.

#### **Course Fee: £2450.**

The course fee includes all teaching sessions, course materials (hard copy and electronic), morning and afternoon refreshments, a welcome reception and two evening meals.

The course fee does not include: all other meals (including lunch and evening meals), travel, accommodation, personal expenses, medical insurance, visa costs and travel insurance. Participants are expected to cover all of these costs.

The deadline for submitting payment is 8 July 2016.

#### **Passports & Visa**
