Ceramics Summer School

The ninth edition of CASC Ceramic's Summer School took place from the 10th to the 12th of September.

The first day was focused on the **mechanical properties of Ceramics** and their use in **Thermal Barrier Coatings and Solid Oxide Fuel Cells**, with the talks of **Dr Finn Giuliani** (*Imperial College*), **Professor Ping Xiao** (*Manchester University*) and **Professor Alan Atkinson** (*Imperial College*).

On Tuesday, we also had the visit from some of the members of the **Additive Manufacturing Initiative for Transnational Innovation in Europe** (*AMITIE*) project as the day was focused on **Additive Manufacturing.** For this, we had a **masterclasses on the basics of additive manufacturing** by **Stephane Richaud** (*Saint Gobai*n) and **Dr Andrea Zocca** (*BAM University and Young Ceramists Additive Manufacturing Network*) together with **two lab sessions** focused on 3D Printing and on the demonstration of some of the mechanical properties discussed on the first day.

We finished the ninth edition of the Summer School with the invited talk of **Dr Rachid M'Saoubi** (SECO Tools) that gave us some industrial examples of the use of ceramics.
