Support	<i>Students will be provided with clear guidance detailing ways to access support throughout their student journey, both at university and departmental levels.</i> • Students will receive clear communications on the range of both academic and pastoral support available through the university and Imperial College Union • Students can be signposted to specialist support teams in the university and will be referred to the most appropriate service when they approach another service.
Connection	<i>University wide services will collaborate with Imperial departments to champion individuality while maintaining equitable experience for students.</i> • All staff will engage with students as future peers and collaborators • Imperial fosters a lifelong connection with students and alumni, both at departmental and university level, through academics, pastoral care and extracurricular activities.
Wellbeing	<i>Imperial will provide academic regulations , policies and processes that are informed by compassion to support physical and mental wellbeing.</i> • Students will have clear paths to access support. • Imperial will have dedicated wellbeing support teams within and outside of departments, catering to differing needs of students
Learning	<i>Students will have opportunities to develop academic and professional skills and access world-class teaching through pedagogical practice as defined by Imperial's Academic departments.</i> • Students are signposted to support for study skills and know how to access it • Students will receive timely, accessible information to support their learning

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Future	<i>Staff will encourage students to engage with services which will support them in the future by providing clear communication and highlighting relevant events.</i> • Students will have the opportunity to engage with the careers services at a University and department level. • Students will have opportunities to expand their learning beyond their programme of study
Space	<i>Imperial is proud of its diverse campuses, and will continue to provide equitable of extracurricular activities, facilities and services across them.</i> • Students will be provided spaces for independent and collaborative study at locations relevant to their programme which are accessible at times which correspond to their schedule.
Activities	<i>Extracurricular activities are a core element of Imperial's commitment to develop graduates of the future and as such, staff will champion opportunities for students to engage with these activities.</i> • Students will have the opportunity to engage in activity opportunities at their primary campus or within a reasonable walking distance through clubs and societies provided by ICU • Students will have the opportunity to access online physical activity opportunities • Students will normally have Wednesday afternoons free to allow for engagement with sport and other extracurricular activities.
