

Fiberoptic endoscopic evaluation of swallowing (FEES)

16 & 17 September 2019

18 September 2019 (optional half-day workshop)



FEES is well established as an instrumental tool for both the evaluation and treatment of swallowing difficulty. This course presents a unique opportunity to focus on both the interpretation of FEES examinations and the formulation of treatment plans for patients with swallowing difficulty arising from a variety of aetiologies.
