DIRECTOR OF THE GRANTHAM INSTITUTE FOR CLIMATE CHANGE

The College is pleased to announce the appointment of Professor Sir Brian Hoskins FRS as the Director of the Grantham Institute for Climate Change in the Faculty of Natural Sciences. Sir Brian will take up this role on 1st January 2008.

Professor Sir Brian Hoskins is a world-leading authority on climate issues and global weather patterns who uses mathematical models to understand weather systems in different parts of the world and how they interact. He was a scientific advisor to the Stern Review and was a member of the IPCC assessment team recently awarded the Nobel Prize. He also built one of the world's foremost meteorology departments at the University of Reading and, from 1st January 2008, will share his time as a Royal Society Research Professor between Imperial College and Reading.
