## Freedom of Information Act request, IMPFOI-23-510, Asbestos in College buildings Imperial College response

The College has in place a comprehensive <u>Asbestos Management Plan</u>. As part of the Asbestos Management Plan, the Asbestos Management team at the College have a mandate to undertake all necessary works for the safe maintenance of asbestos and asbestos containing materials, and its removal where necessary.

- 1. Do any of the buildings at Imperial College London contain asbestos?
- 2. If yes, please outline how many university-owned buildings contain asbestos, which buildings these are and if any of these are student accommodation.

There are 63 Imperial Buildings with Asbestos Containing Materials (ACMs), 12 of these are Halls of Residences the remainder being academic buildings.

3. Have there been any health problems as a result reported to the university in the last 10 years? Please detail how many and their nature.

The College does not hold a record of health problems "reported to the university". The College has settled three claims in the time-period specified relating to historic asbestos exposure (there are no outstanding claims).

4. Has the university paid any compensation to students, and if so, how many and how much money in total in 10 years?

The College has not paid any compensation to students (including former students) over the past ten years for claims relating to asbestos exposure.
