

Q. Are there any costs associated with the programme?

A. No. All Outreach programmes are free to attend but you have to arrange and pay for your own travel with the exception of the Y12 Sutton Trust Summer School where travel expenses are reimbursed.

Q. If I don't get a place, can I pay and still come?

A. No. We have a limited number of spaces and these are given according to our eligibility criteria.

Q. Where will I sleep?

A. In an en-suite single or twin room in single or mixed sex blocks. If you are offered a place or a waiting list place you will be able to select a preference of which block you would like to be in.

Q. If I am on a residential programme, do I have to stay in the accommodation provided?

A. Yes. Living in halls of residence is an important experience which will give you a better idea of what University life could be like.

Q. If I get accepted alongside a friend, can we request to share a room?

A. No. One of the aims of our programmes is to develop your communication skills and as such we don't place people who know each other in the same room.

Q. Can I attend part of the programme if I am unavailable for some of it e.g. I am on a holiday?

A. No. Our programmes are designed to build up on your knowledge with a presentation of your work at the end so it is very important that you take part in all of the sessions.
