

## **Post Graduation Days 2026 Survey Terms and Conditions**

1. The prize draw is open to graduands of Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine (“Imperial College London” or the “Promoter”) who responded to Imperial’s Post Graduation Days 2026 Survey except any third party directly associated with the administration of the prize draw.
2. The prize draw is free to enter.
3. All entries will be submitted by opting into participation in the draw in the Post Graduation Days 2026 Survey, and only one submission per person is permitted.
4. The opening date for entries is 08.00 BST on Thursday 4 June. The prize draw's closing date is 13.00 GMT on Thursday 2 July 2026. Entries received after this time will not be considered. Participants will be deemed to have entered the draw when they submit their response to Imperial College London’s Post Graduation Days 2026 Survey.
5. Imperial College London accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure of any kind.
6. One winner will be chosen by a random draw supervised by an independent person. The draw will be completed by Wednesday 8 July 2026.
7. The winner will receive one £100 Amazon voucher. The winner will be notified by email (using details provided at entry) before Friday 10 July 2026. The prize will be sent to the winner using the same email address within 21 days of being notified of their win. If a winner does not respond to the Promoter within 21 days of being notified by the Promoter, then the winner's prize will be forfeited, and the Promoter will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.
8. The prize for the winner is non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and no cash alternative is offered.
9. Imperial College London reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond its control make it necessary to do so.
10. The decision of Imperial College London regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
11. Imperial College London must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. If you object to any or all of your surname, country and winning entry being published or made available, please contact [graduation@imperial.co.uk](mailto:graduation@imperial.co.uk). In such circumstances, Imperial College London must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

12. Participants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry. Imperial College London reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

13. Imperial College London reserves the right to hold, void, cancel, suspend, or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.

As is permitted by law, Imperial College London will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of Imperial College London, its agents or distributors or that of their employees.
