- A member of a number of Government Technical Advisory Committees, Paul also chairs the Advisory Board of the Imperial College Institute of Security Science and Technology.
- He is currently advising and exercising a number of global retail and investment banks at board level, helping to address their cyber and information protection challenges. Paul sits on a number of bank Board Risk Committee Advisory Panels.
