

Behavioural Rules for users of space in the Department of Computing in 2021/22

Issued by the Head of Department of Computing, *version of 1 March 2022*

Considering the newsletter of 24 February 2022, sent by College to staff and students, Computing has updated and considerably simplified its behavioural rules for use of its space as follows:

1. We will continue with the current approach to our teaching till the end of Spring Term.
2. Staff and students are asked to take regular COVID tests before visiting campus, and to report test results using the [self-declaration form](#) for PCR tests, and via [MyImperial](#) for LFD tests.
3. Staff and students should not attend campus if they show any symptoms of COVID.
4. Staff and students are expected to wear face coverings in most teaching, office and lab spaces when in crowded and enclosed spaces.
5. Staff and students can remove face coverings in non-crowded settings but need to be mindful of the feelings and concerns of others.

We hope that the lowering of national infection rates will soon be reflected in those rates for College and that we can increase occupancy capacity of our rooms gradually, hopefully after the Spring Term. We will communicate any updates here, including any changes pertaining to the items 2-5 above.

We encourage staff and students to return to campus and Computing, to benefit from increased F2F interactions. If you have any questions or concerns about this new approach, please get in touch.
