

Project Submission Instructions for MSc Students

Please submit your FINAL electronic MSc Project in a PDF format. Note: close to this deadline the electronic upload may become slow. You are strongly advised to have an early upload in place at least one hour before the deadline in case any last-minute submission goes wrong. It is your responsibility to submit everything on time.

You can re-submit a newer version of your project anytime up to the deadline; the **latest version present in the app at the deadline** will be accepted.

You will have had an in-person Turnitin session with the EEE librarian who will show you how Turnitin can be used to support you in avoiding plagiarism, how to generate a Similarity report and how to interpret a Similarity report. This session will **not** be recorded.

BLACKBOARD SUBMISSION FOR REPORT PLAGIARISM CHECKING

You can submit early versions (separated by 24 hours) of your project report to the MSc Cohort Blackboard module for Turnitin checking. You should already be enrolled in this module. Once you have uploaded your report PDF, you can then download a Turnitin Similarity Report. Please make sure that the version you upload to the Blackboard module by the deadline is the same final version you submit on the app, as this is the version we will use for plagiarism checking.

Once you submit your project report on Blackboard for Turnitin checking, you cannot resubmit another version for 24 hours, please bear this in mind near the deadline.

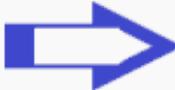
IMPORTANT: FINAL REPORT SUBMISSION

1. Your Final Project Report a must be submitted on time to the [EEE app](#) (as below).
2. Allow time for EEE app uploads near the deadline. Slow upload is not a valid mitigating circumstance for failure to meet the deadline, and many uploads at the same time will make the system slow.
3. You are strongly advised to upload a “safety” report copy more than two hours before the deadline.
4. Incorrect use of images in a PDF document can lead to very large PDF size. Any report larger than 30MB should be PDF compressed before upload. This can be done with a web compression utility, such as Adobe. Check how to do this well before the deadline.

FINAL REPORT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

2. To submit your Project:
 - a. Click on *Submit Project* button
 - b. Student can update the project title before submitting the report. If there is no change click *Continue without Change* button
