

Project Submission Instructions for MSc Students

Please submit your FINAL electronic MSc Project in a PDF format by 4:00pm, THURSDAY 3rd SEPTEMBER 2020.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE SUBMISSION OF YOUR PROJECT IS IN THREE PARTS. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU COMPLETE SUBMISSIONS IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- BLACKBOARD TURNITIN
- IN THE APP – TURNITIN REPORT
- IN THE APP – PROJECT

YOU MUST ALSO ENSURE THAT FILE UPLOAD IS COMPLETED BY 4.00PM FOR BOTH BLACKBOARD TURNITIN AND THE APP. FILES UPLOADED TO BOTH SITES MUST BE IDENTICAL IN CONTENT.

Turnitin is software the Department uses to help detect plagiarism. You are able to re-submit a newer version of your project anytime up to the deadline; the version that is present in Blackboard on 3rd September at 4pm will be accepted as your FINAL version.

You may find it useful to submit a draft version of your project earlier than the deadline date and then view the Similarity Report to check for possible plagiarism and improve your referencing. It is not expected that you would need to resubmit more than 1 or 2 times whilst improving your work. Please see the Turnitin guides in the Library Resources folder for more information.

Please note: once you have submitted your work, you will not be able to resubmit another version for 24 hours. You MUST leave sufficient time before the deadline to ensure you can submit the final version of your project for assessment.

Remote Turnitin sessions will be held where you can ask advice on your Similarity Report from the EEE Librarian. Sessions are scheduled for Tuesday 1st September 2020 from 10:00-11:00am and Wednesday 2nd September 2020 from 2:00-3:00pm. You will be sent reminder emails nearer the time.

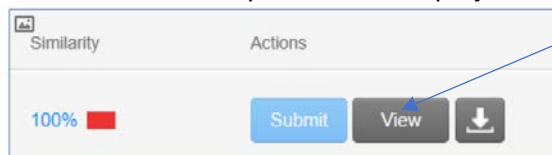

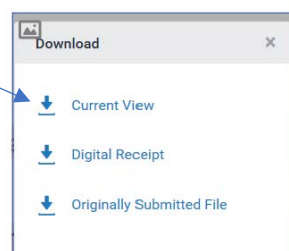
4. You will receive an email confirming that your submission has been made.
5. At this point, you have submitted your project on Blackboard via Turnitin for an originality check. You know have to download the submitted project with originality report as a PDF.
6. Under 'ELEC9 Electrical Engineering MSc Project Dropbox (2019-2020)', click on 'View/Complete.'
7. You will see your submitted project. Click the 'view' button.



8. Your MSc project will appear, highlighting any areas of plagiarism. Click the 'Download button', before clicking 'Current View.'
