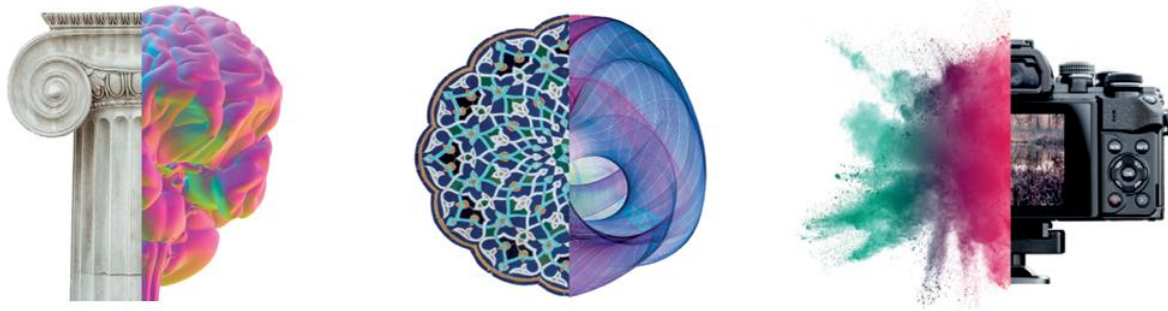

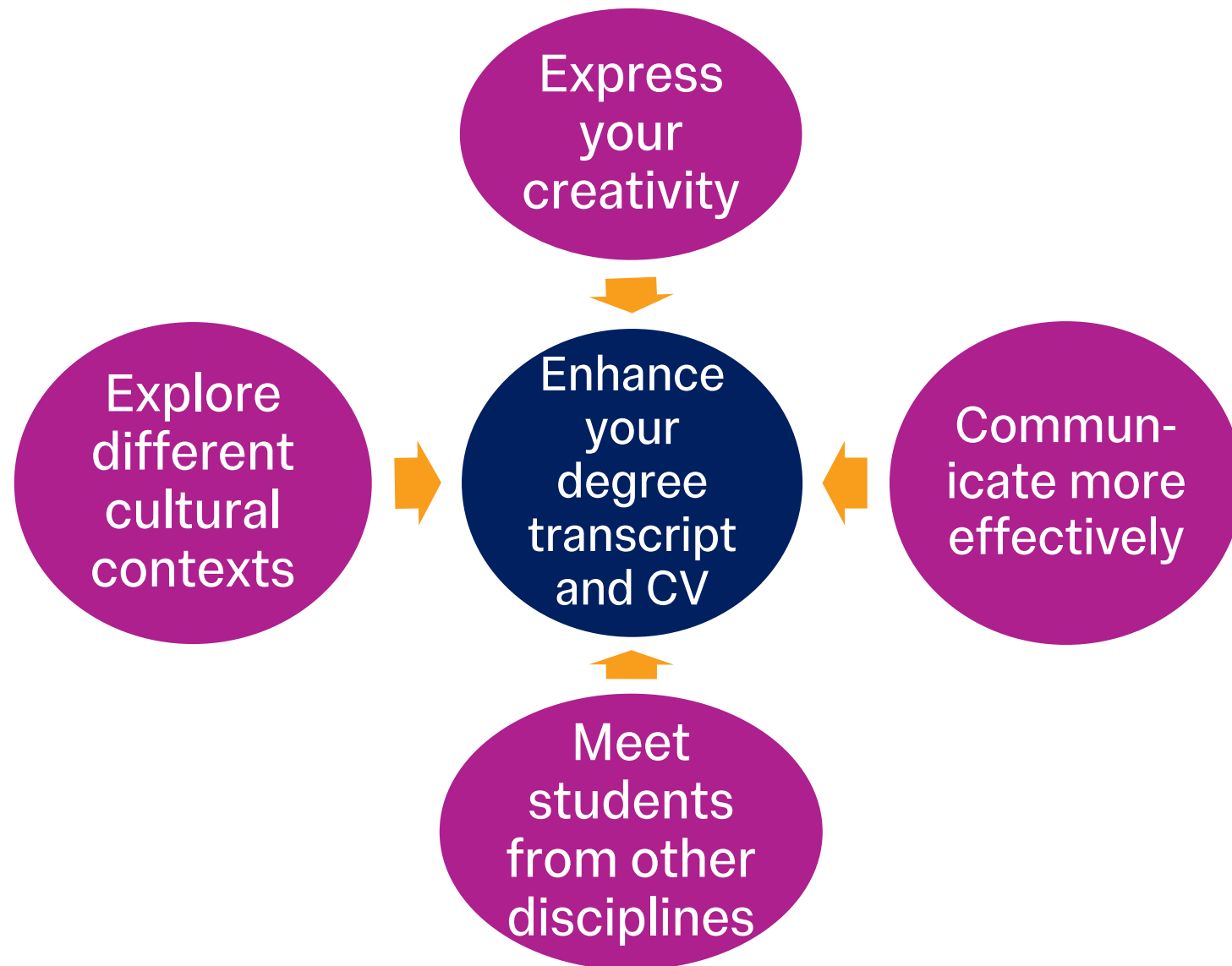

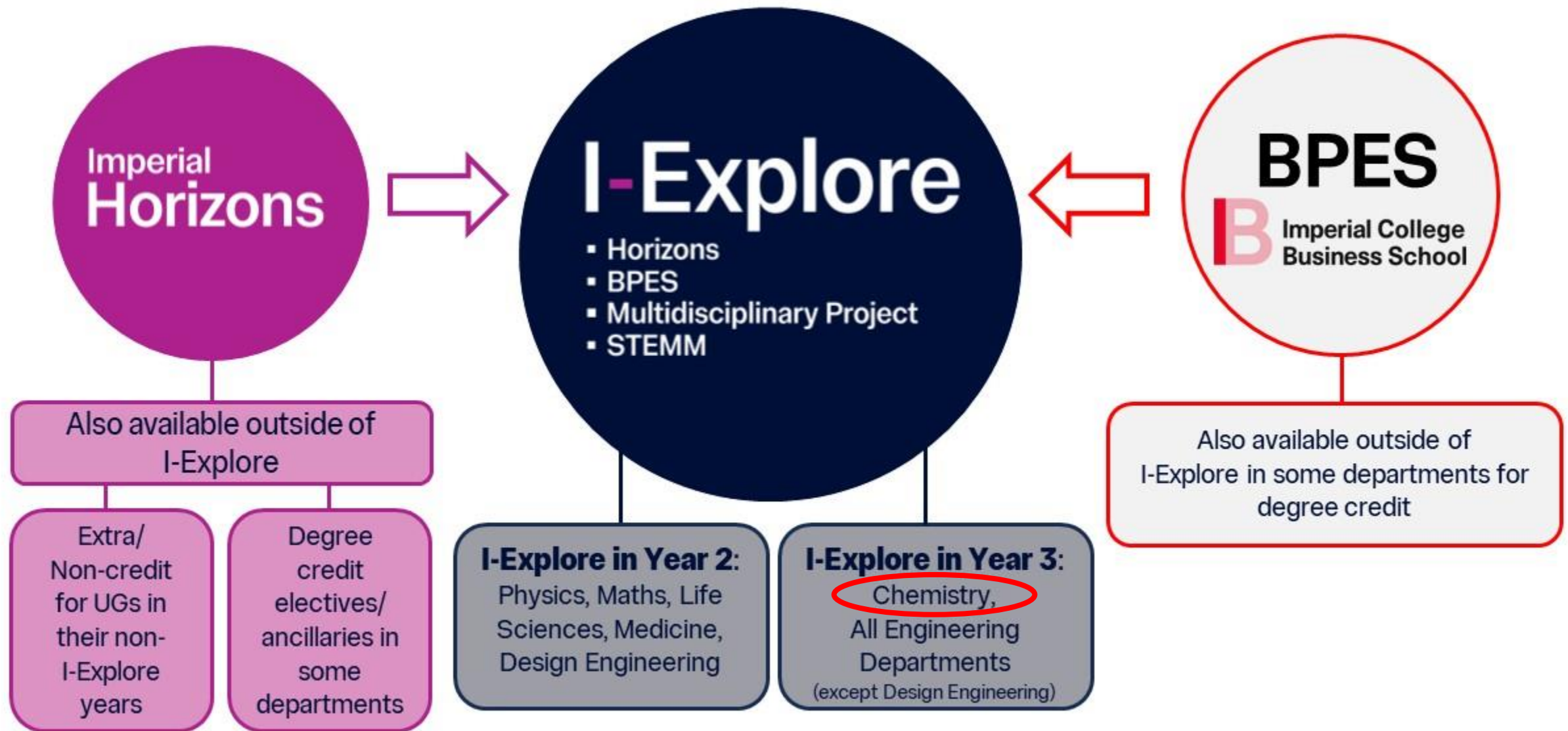
Horizons options for Chemistry UGs

- **Year 1:** students can take a Language module, for degree-credit (two-terms). Students can take an 8-week non-Languages module for non-credit instead if they wish.
- **Year 2:** students have choice from across the whole Horizon's module offering, plus modules offered by the Business School, through the BPES programme.
- **Year 3:** Students will take an Horizons module, or another non-Chemistry module, as part of the I-Explore programme.

What is I-Explore?

- Imperial College London programme integrated into all UG degrees.
- Module options outside your degree discipline in Languages, Humanities, Change Makers, STEMM and BPES (business).
- Compulsory to take one module in **either Year 2 or Year 3** of your degree.
- This will be **Year 3 for Chemistry students**
- Your I-Explore module will count towards your degree and be included on your UG transcript.





Other CLCC language-learning opportunities

- **Language Exchange** – a language pairing initiative to learn from a native speaker.
- **Research Abroad programme** – options for a year abroad where students undertake research instead of university study.
- **Imperial after:hours** – evening classes in a range of subjects
