PERSPECTIVES IN EDUCATION EVENT:

Professor Peter Lepage: Large-Scale Pedagogical Change at a Large Research University

There is a substantial and growing body of research – many hundreds of papers – that has identified several pedagogical approaches that are significantly more effective than traditional lecturing, even for large classes in conventional auditoriums. And yet traditional lecturing still dominates in most subjects at most institutions.

This talk, delivered at Imperial on 06 December 2017, by Peter Lepage, Goldwin Smith Professor of Physics at Cornell University, describes a program launched five years ago at Cornell, by its College of Arts and Sciences, to address this contradiction. In the program's first iteration, large introductory course sequences in physics and biology were transformed by their respective departments.

The program recently grew to include projects in 9 departments, affecting more than 70 faculty and thousands of students annually.

The talk discussed what was done, why and how it was done, and some of the impressive outcomes that followed from the changes. The talk also discussed institutional challenges and opportunities created by such projects, from the perspective of the (then) dean.
