THE CHALLENGE:

Every year, 3,000 extremely preterm babies in the UK face the risk of necrotising enterocolitis (NEC), a life-threatening gut condition. Whether pasteurised donor milk, preterm formula, and bovine fortifier, as used in neonatal care, affect severe NEC, neurodevelopment and other outcomes, is not known
