



What is this project about?

This is a national study aimed at improving neonatal service delivery for babies born between 27 and 31 weeks of gestation in England.

OPTIPREM will use anonymised data from the National Neonatal Research Database (NNRD) to develop a national policy on the best place of care for babies born at 27 to 31 weeks of gestation.

Does this include data on my baby?

If your baby was born between 27 and 31 weeks gestation, then his/her data will be included. However, we will remove the names, dates of birth and other identifiable information so that all babies in the study will be anonymous. If you do not want us to include your baby in this study, please let your local contact or chief investigator (see below) know so that we can remove your baby's details before we do the analysis.
