

Guidance for students on what to expect from an in-person Graduate School workshop

The Graduate School is following the latest [College guidance for the management of Covid-19](#).

Please read this document before signing up to an in-person workshop so that you understand our expectations. Most Graduate School courses are also available remotely, giving you choice to decide which mode of delivery you are most comfortable with.

Vaccinations

- The College is very strongly encouraging vaccination, including boosters.

Testing

- In line with government guidance, regular testing is no longer encouraged.
- You are no longer required to report positive tests to College, unless you are living in College Halls of residence in which case you should continue to report any COVID-19 positive test results [via MyImperial](#).

Stay at home if you don't feel well

- If you are displaying symptoms of respiratory disease, please inform your Graduate School tutor and consider attending a remote version of the workshop.

Cover your coughs and sneezes

- When attending an in-person Graduate School workshop, please cover your coughs and sneezes to reduce the spread of particles carrying Covid-19 and other viruses.

Respect personal space

- For the comfort and wellbeing of others, please respect people's wishes for extra space where possible.

Use of hand sanitiser

- Where hand sanitiser is available for use in a Graduate School workshop, you are encouraged to use it.

Face coverings

- You are encouraged to wear a face covering indoors, especially in crowded, enclosed spaces, unless you are exempt. This includes **for Graduate School workshops**.
